



## Conflict Minerals – Position Statement

**Subject:** Conflict Mineral Assessment Regarding the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act

March 9, 2015

To Our Valued Partners:

Amphenol RF is aware of its obligations under Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act (DFWSCPA) regarding use of Conflict Minerals (CM's) sourced from the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and its adjoining countries. This legislation was introduced in July 2010 and the enabling regulations promulgated on August 22, 2012. As a publically traded company, reporting of Conflict Mineral usage is filed by Amphenol with the SEC annually in accordance with the law.

To be in compliance with this regulation, Amphenol RF actively surveys our supply chain regarding the origin of Conflict Minerals used in our products. Amphenol RF's CM assessment program provides for accurate reporting of CM usage and ensures appropriate reasonable country of origin inquiry (RCOI) due diligence is performed.

To date Amphenol RF has not confirmed any use of CM's from the Democratic Republic of Congo or its adjoining countries as defined in the DFWSRCPA as supporting or contributing to conflict in the region. However, survey of our supply chain is an ongoing and evolving effort. We are committed to continue this process and with providing accurate information from our due diligence activities.
